

Concessional Club Car Registration

Members of the British Ford Car Club can apply for concessional car registration under the Queensland Government's Special Interest Vehicle Scheme.

Registration under this scheme has restrictions and penalties for non-compliance. Full details of this scheme (including the application form) can be found at <https://www.qld.gov.au/transport/registration/fees/concession/special-interest>.

When submitting the registration concession application (F3937), you will be required to provide one or both of the following:

- a) **Proof of membership to an incorporated club** – on club letterhead, including the vehicle details (make, model, year and chassis number).

The club's Dating Officer* can provide such a letter provided that

- i. For new members – 2 years membership plus joining fee is paid, or that it can be confirmed that the member has attended at least 3 club functions
- ii. For existing members – membership fee is up to date.

- b) **Dating Certificate** (if the Department of Transport and Main roads cannot verify the date of manufacture for the vehicle) – this certificate can be provided by the club's Dating Officer once he has sighted the vehicle (in person or by photos).

The conditions and restrictions imposed upon the vehicle allow for participation in rallies or events organised by an incorporated vehicle club, for as long as club membership is maintained.

It is a requirement that paperwork to support the reason for travel is kept in the vehicle. Such paperwork could be club newsletter and/or club calendar of events.

Should the vehicle be used outside the conditions of the Special Interest Vehicle scheme, the registration concession could be revoked, or a fine imposed. Additionally any third party insurance may become null and void.

The conditions of this QLD scheme continue to apply interstate.
